HELPFUL HINTS

HOW DO YOU CHOOSE A CONTRACTOR WHO WILL BEST REPRESENT YOUR NEEDS?

- Choose a professional restoration contractor with a proven track record, one that can document that they are properly licensed and insured. You need to know that the company you choose will be around in the years to come, to stand behind their work.
- Be cautious of contractors that try to "buy" your business by waiving your deductible (which may be illegal) or giving you a free material upgrade.
 Chances are they will make this up by short-changing you somewhere else in the project.
- If you want to know how professional your potential contractor really is, make a surprise visit to their office during business hours. Ask for references.



• The insurance restoration process can be long, arduous and confusing. Your contractor should explain the various steps in the process to you, so you'll know what to expect, and then you should be kept informed as the job progresses.



- Choose a contractor who will meet your adjustor at the property to review the entire scope of loss.
 Have your contractor go over the paperwork with you, so you clearly understand the extent of your damage.
- Your contractor should understand how funds are disbursed by the insurance company and in some cases the mortgage company. They should be working on your behalf to get you paid quickly. Unless you are having work done that is outside the scope that was approved by the insurance company, your only out-of-pocket expense should be your insurance deductible.



- Find a contractor who will only install quality materials. Remember, the contractor only warrants the installation of the materials, the materials themselves are guaranteed by the manufacturer.
- Your contractor should always install these materials in accordance with manufacturer's specifications and local building codes. There should be an on-site Project Manager to oversee the work.
- Your contractor should have the safety of his workers as a primary concern during construction. All OSHA guidelines should be followed at all times.
- An experienced roofing contractor will make sure that every possible precaution is being taken to protect your property and landscaping from falling debris. At the end of the work day and certainly when the job is over, a thorough clean up, including rolling the entire landscape with a magnetic roller, should be done.
- After the work is completed, your contractor should review the job with you, walking around the jobsite to make sure that everything has been done to your satisfaction.

WHY SHOULD YOU SELECT AMERICAN BUILDING CONTRACTORS?

Filing your insurance claim can be intimidating, especially if you have never done so before. Remember that it is for instances like this you have been faithfully paying your premiums. You rely on your insurance company to make a fair assessment of the damage to your property and provide compensation to bring it back to the condition it was before the storm. The only way to ensure they do this is to have a contractor like American Building Contractors in your corner who understands the restoration process.



Knowing how to install a good roof or how to replace siding, gutters or windows is not enough. You need a contractor who knows how to identify damage, write an accurate scope, work with adjustors & read an itemized statement of loss. The insurance company has experts working for them, but who do you think they are looking out for; you or the company that pays them? Your insurance company is a business and, like every business, their goal is to make money. The easiest way for an insurance company to do this is to limit how much they pay out on claims.

It can be easy to be intimidated by an insurance company. They have money, they have lawyers, they have roofing engineers and they don't need to be in a hurry to do anything. Sometimes dragging things out as long as possible is their best weapon in getting policyholders to accept less than they are actually due. If your property has damage and your insurance company denies your claim or only agrees to pay for a minor repair or "appearance allowance" you need a contractor like American Building Contractors who has dealt with these types of difficult

situations in the past and is ready to help you now.

THREE TIPS INSURANCE COMPANIES DON'T WANT YOU TO KNOW:

- 1. You don't need to get multiple estimates (or any estimates at all, for that matter)! The insurance company will set the price for the fair market value of the loss. Of course, if you use a contractor who charges less, then they will pay less. The insurance company is only required to pay for as much as your contractor invoices you.
- 2. The insurance pricing (in most cases) is sufficiently high enough to hire a professional insurance restoration contractor. The insurance company is willing to pay for you to use a reputable company who will perform quality work and provide a meaningful warranty. You don't want to shop around for a "bargain basement" contractor. This will only save the insurance company money.



3. You are free to choose any contractor you want to do the work! You are not required to use one of their "Preferred Vendors".
